MOTION FOR CONSOLIDATION

PETITIONER DEVELOPMENT BANK OF THE PHILIPPINES (DBP), by counsel, to this Honorable Court, most respectfully states:

- On August 22, 2007, DBP filed the instant Petition for Review dated August 21, 2007, where it is alleged inter alia that:
 - "1. It must be disclosed that there are other pending cases pertaining to DBP's TCT Nos. 247959 and 247960, (subject matter of the present petition) namely:
 - 1.1 <u>G.R No. 175728</u> [Second Division of the Supreme Court] entitled <u>DBP vs. PNA</u> which is a Petition for Review under Rule 45, filed by DBP questioning the granting of Certiorari in CA GR SP No.-85870.
 - 1.1.1 This present case must be consolidated with the with C.A. SP No. 85870 (now G.R. No. 175728), because the issue involved in this case is which is the implementation of the previously granted writ of

possession thru the issuance of a writ of demolition is closely intertwined with C.A- G. R. SP No. 85870 (now G.R. No. 175728), which is the propriety of the writ of possession, thus,

"The rationale for consolidation is to have all cases intimately related acted upon by one Court/Division to avoid the possibility of conflicting decisions in cases involving the same facts and common questions of law. The cases before the 10th Division and the 9th Division of the Court of Appeals are two (2) such intimately and substantially related cases. Consolidation being called for it cannot be justifiably argued, as private respondents do, that BENGUET is estopped from pleading for such consolidation. To deny the transfer could lead to further protracted litigations to the detriment of the efficient and effective determination of actions and proceedings." (Benguet vs C.A, 165 SCRA 265 [G.R. No. 80902. August 31, 1988.]

- 1.1.2 Considering that the issue in this case which is the propriety of a writ of demolition cannot be resolved without touching on the issue of the propriety of the issuance of the writ of possession, the two (2) cases should be immediately consolidated. The consolidation is aimed at avoiding inconsistent dispositions by the Courts on substantially the same issues.
- 2. It is respectfully reiterated that there should be consolidation of this case with <u>G.R No. 175728</u>, which is pending with the Second Division of this Honorable Supreme Court, to avoid the possibility of conflicting decisions in the said cases which involve the same facts and common questions of law.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, it is most respectfully prayed of the Honorable Supreme Court that this case be ordered consolidated with G.R. No. 175728 pending with the Second Division of the Supreme Court.

Other reliefs just and equitable in the premises are similarly prayed for.

1. On <u>September 5, 2006</u>, petitioner DBP received a copy of the Decision of the Court of Appeals promulgated on August 28, 2006, the dispositive portion of which provides:

"WHEREFORE, premises considered, Petition is hereby DISMISSED. The questioned Orders of Br. 92, Regional Trial Court, Quezon City dated November 30, 2004 and January 17, 2005 respectively, in LRC Case No. Q-17793 are hereby AFFIRMED in toto.

2. On <u>September 19, 2006</u>, petitioner filed a Motion for Reconsideration dated September 12, 2006 with the Court of Appeals.

- 5. Under Rule 45, DBP has only fifteen (15) days from its receipt of the Resolution of the Court of Appeals, or until <u>August 8, 2007</u>, within which to file its Petition for Review on Certiorari assailing the said Decision/Resolution.
- 6. Due to pressure of work in other equally important cases, undersigned counsel will be unable to file the said petition on time. An additional period of fifteen (15) days from August 8, 2007, or until <u>August 23, 2007</u>, is thus needed to do so.
- This motion is prompted solely by the foregoing reason and not intended for delay.
- 8 DBP, in accordance with the 1997 Rules of Civil Procedure, has paid the full and proper docket and other lawful fees for its Petition, and deposited the proper amount for costs.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, it is most respectfully prayed that Petitioner DBP be granted an extension of fifteen (15) days from August 8, 2007, or until August 23, 2007, within which to file its Petition for Review on Certiorari before this Honorable Court.
